

Generix Stone Cladding – FAQs

1. What is the thickness of the stone?

- a. The Generix system is available in thicknesses of 20 and 30mm stone.

2. What are the standard sizes of the stone panels?

- a. This depends upon the stone type, however the standard size is 900mm long by 600mm high - if larger panels are required, please contact us.

3. Can the system be installed vertically?

- a. Yes it is possible to install the system in portrait as well as landscape.

4. Is the system faster to install than traditional handset stone cladding?

- a. Yes, it is typically 2.5/3 times faster to install than traditional handset stone cladding.

5. What are the joint sizes?

- a. Typically 6mm vertical and horizontal. The horizontal is always 6mm, however the vertical can be customised.

6. Can you supply cills, copings and other architectural features in the same stone?

- a. Yes, cills and copings are available in the same stone and fabricated specials are also available.

7. Can you supply the system with curved (radius) panels?

- a. Yes this is possible - please contact our team for more information.
