Cork is obtained from the bark of cork oak trees (*Quercus suber*) without cutting the trees down. The bark naturally regenerates every 9 to 12 years, enabling repeated harvesting while keeping the trees healthy and intact.

CARBON SEQUESTRATION

Cork oak forests act as highly effective carbon sinks, taking in more carbon dioxide (CO₂) than they emit. The process of bark regeneration enhances this effect by capturing additional CO₂, resulting in a net carbon-negative contribution.

WATER RESISTANT

This collection features cork-inspired designs in a water-resistant format, making it perfect for a wide variety of indoor spaces, such as offices, hotels, libraries, care homes, and restaurants. With a durable, PVC-free finish, it offers a sustainable solution that combines excellent performance with long-lasting quality.

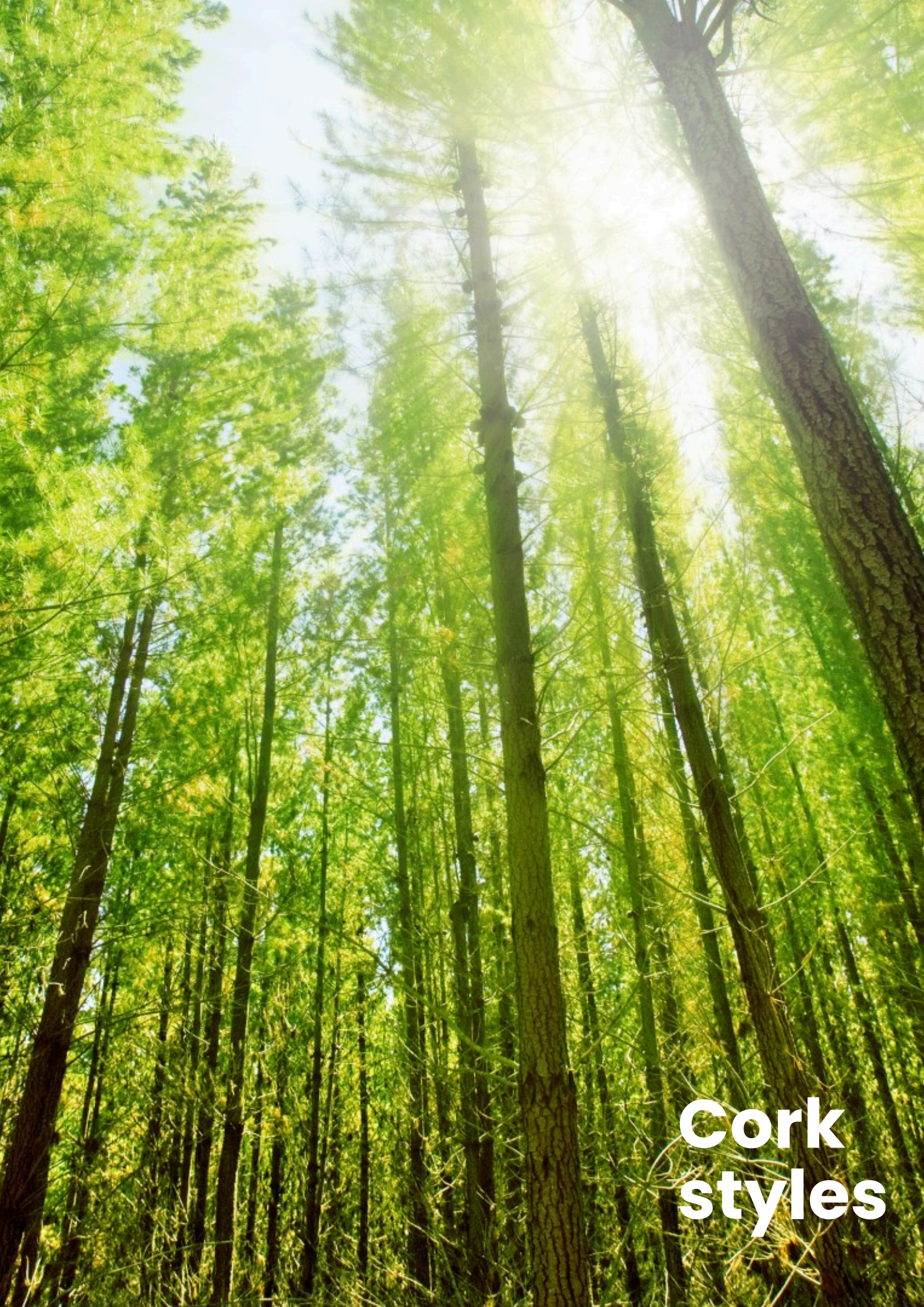
