Taylor Maxwell has long-standing exclusive partnerships with sawmills and suppliers and are often responsible for selling all their output to UK customers, either via our stock facilities in the UK or via trailer service direct from the sawmills.

Relationships with suppliers and customers often go back many years and consequently our customers can be assured of consistent supply once regular business is established. Our key strength is a robust supply chain, with products from a range of suppliers and locations, providing year-round access to our diverse range.













Through a combination of our sales and customer service offices, stock locations and key manufacturing partners, we are able to work with merchant and manufacturing customers across the UK. Our supply is heavily focused toward the UK, Sweden, the Baltics and the rest of the EU, however, we also import specialist products from North America and China. We work with trusted sawmills and partners to offer certified timber and support a sustainable supply chain that will protect and conserve our forests for future generations.



C16

We supply the merchant and manufacturing trade with full and mixed trailer loads of C16 carcassing from our two sawmill suppliers in Ireland: GP Wood and Murray Timber.

'C16' timber refers to the strength class each piece of timber achieves from a grading process and offers the customer a quality and affordable graded timber product delivered via a door-to-door trailer service. C16 timber is most commonly produced in the UK and Ireland using spruce logs from what are commonly referred to as 'homegrown' forests and sawmills.

Taylor Maxwell is one of the UK's largest stockists and distributors of C24 graded timber.



Oak boules offer good lengths, added flexibility and consistency of colour and material. We source small parcels of exceptional quality or value, to sell through our stock. We are able to offer air dried and kiln dried across the standard French size ranges.




